- **An illustration that took forever:** This 1,000 piece puzzle is a Big Potato original, illustrated and designed by one of our top illustrators.



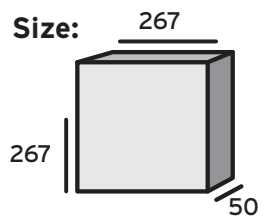
## DID YOU KNOW?
